

# Happy Flower Crochet Mandala Pattern



## Pattern Details

To create the **Happy Flower Crochet Mandala**, follow these detailed instructions. This project is designed to be cheerful and colorful, making it a perfect quick crochet project.

## Materials Needed

- **Crochet Hook:** 3.5mm
- **Darning Needle**
- **Scissors**
- **Yarn:** Any brand of 8ply Cotton or Cotton Blend (e.g., Patons 8 ply Cotton Blend)
- **Colors:**

- Colour A: Teal
- Colour B: White
- Colour C: Soft Pink
- Colour D: Mid Pink
- Colour E: Soft Green
- Colour F: Yellow
- Colour G: Purple

## **Beginning Popcorn**

1. Chain 3.
2. Yarn over, insert hook into the same chain space, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops (2 loops remain).
3. Repeat this process until you have 4 loops on the hook, then yarn over and pull through all 4 loops.

## **4DC Popcorn**

1. Yarn over, insert hook into the next chain space, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops (2 loops remain).
2. Repeat until you have 5 loops on the hook, then yarn over and pull through all remaining loops.

## **Abbreviations**

- Beg: beginning
- BLO: back loops only
- Ch: chain
- Dc: double crochet
- Hdc: half double crochet
- MR: magic ring
- Sc: single crochet
- Sk: skip
- Sl st: slip stitch
- St: stitch

## **Round-by-Round Guide**

### **Round 1**



Begin with Color A. Create a magic ring (MR) and work six single crochets (sc) into it.

## **Round 2**



Work 2 sc in each stitch. Fasten off and join Colour B.

### Round 3



Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet), then make a double crochet in the same stitch. Next, perform 2 double crochets in each stitch across the row. Continue until the end. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the initial chain. Fasten off and switch to Colour C.

### Round 4



Chain 2 (counts as a half double crochet), perform a half double crochet in the same stitch.

Chain 1, skip the next 2 double crochets, then make 2 half double crochets in the same space.

Repeat these steps until the end. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the initial chain. Fasten off and join Colour D in a chain space [24 hdc & 12 ch].

### **Round 5**





Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet), then execute 2 double crochets in the same space.\*(Chain 1, 3 double crochets in the next chain space)\*

Continue this pattern to the end. Secure the round with a slip stitch to the top of the initial chain and fasten off. Attach Colour E in a chain space [36 double crochets & 12 chains].

### **Round 6**



In the first chain space, work (*chain 3, dc, chain 2, 2 dc*); then in each chain space (*2 dc, chain 2, 2 dc*) until the end. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning chain and fasten off. Join Colour F in a chain space [48 dc & 24 ch].

### **Round 7**



Work Beginning Popcorn in each appropriate space followed by a chain of five; repeat (*4 DC Popcorn, chain 5*) until finished. Join with a slip stitch at the top of the beginning chain and fasten off. Join Colour G [12 Popcorns & 60 ch].

### Round 8



Chain one; work six sc in each chain five space and one sc on top of each popcorn stitch. Slip stitch to beginning chain and fasten off. Join Colour C into sc above a popcorn stitch [84 sc].

### Round 9





Chain one; work two sc in the same stitch; (*sc in each of the next six sc, two sc in same sc above popcorn from Round 7*) until finished. Join with a slip stitch to beginning stitch and fasten off. Join Colour A [96 sc].

### Round 10



Chain one; sc in same stitch; skip three stitches and work shells as follows: (*dc, chain one five times, skip three stitches*) repeat around to finish. Fasten off.
