Little Mermaid Amigurumi Free Pattern



Pattern Description:

This crochet pattern guides crocheters in creating a "Little Mermaid" amigurumi doll. It is a free, detailed pattern, intended for personal use to reproduce this specific character.

The pattern includes instructions for the doll and various outfits, such as a pink dress and a blue dress.

Materials Needed & Measurements:

• Yarn:

- **YarnArt Jeans** is the recommended brand, which comes in one size and is typically worked with a 3 or 3.5 mm hook.
- Colors required: Pink, Light Pink, White, Peach, Turquoise, Light blue, Navy blue, Green, Mint green, Red, Violet, and tiny scraps of Black for eye embroideries. All yarn should be of the same size.

- Hook:
 - o 2.0 mm hook.
 - o 3.0 mm hook.
- Notions:
 - o Tapestry needle.
 - o 8mm black safety eyes.
 - **Stuffing** (poly fiber fill or other).
- **Measurements:** Finished size: approx. **13 x 5 cm** (with YarnArt Jeans & 2.0 mm hook, worked tightly)
- Skill level: Intermediate.

Stitches & Abbreviations Used:

- R = Round (continuous or joined)
- $\mathbf{Row} = \mathbf{row}$
- MR = Magic Ring
- $\mathbf{st} = \mathbf{stitch}$
- sk = skip
- sc = single crochet
- inc = sc increase (invisible sc increase; 1st sc in FL, 2nd through entire st when in rounds; [2 sc] through entire st when in rows)
- **dec** = sc decrease (invisible sc decrease when in rounds; sc2tog when in rows)
- dc = double crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- \bullet ch = chain
- sl = slip stitch
- tr = treble crochet
- **BLO** = back loop only (inner loop when in rounds)
- **FLO** = front loop only (outer loop when in rounds)
- [] = stitches to be done in the same loop or stitch
- **CY-PO** = cut the yarn and pull it out from the stitch
- IJ = Invisible Join
- FO = fasten off (CY-PO + IJ)
- stsc = standing sc

• tch = turning chain

Instructions for Making the Little Mermaid Amigurumi Pattern:

Doll Base

- Legs (Peach, 2.0 mm hook)
- Make 2. Do not stuff.
 - o **R1:** 6 sc in MR (6)
 - o **R2–R13:** 6 sc (6)
- FO after first leg. Do not cut yarn after second leg, continue to body.

Body (switch to Violet at join)

- R14: 3 sc on 2nd leg, ch 2, 6 sc on 1st leg (start at R13), 2 sc on back side of ch, 3 sc on 2nd leg (16)
- **R15–R17:** 16 sc (16)
- **R18:** switch to Peach, BLO 16 sc (16)
- **R19:** (3 sc, dec) x 3, 1 sc (13)
- **R20:** 13 sc (13)
- **R21:** (2 sc, dec) x 3, 1 sc (10)
- **R22:** 5 sc, dec, 2 sc, 1 dec BLO (8) \leftarrow creates space for bra
- **R23:** 8 sc (start stuffing firmly)
- **R24:** (2 sc, dec) x 2 (6)
- R25–R27: $6 \text{ sc } (6) \leftarrow \text{neck}$

Do not FO, continue to head.

Head (Peach)

- **R28:** 6 inc (12)
- **R29:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
- **R30:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
- **R31:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)
- **R32:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

- **R33-R40:** 36 sc (36) Place 8 mm safety eyes between **R36 & R37**, 7 sts apart. Embroider eyelashes with black thread. Indent eyes with skin-colored thread before final stuffing.
- **R41:** (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)
- **R42:** (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)
- **R43:** (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)
- **R44:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)
- **R45**: 6 dec (6)

FO, leave long tail. Pass through front loops, pull tight to close. Hide yarn.

Arms (make 2, Peach)

- **R1:** 5 sc in MR (5)
- **R2-R10:** 5 sc (5)
- Flatten end: sl st, turn, sk sl, 2 sc, sl st. FO leaving long tail. Do not stuff.
- Attach arms 2 rounds below the bra.

Mermaid Outfit

- Bra (Violet)
- Work into 4 centered FLO loops left from R21 of body:
 - Join with stsc in 1st FLO, ch 1, 1 hdc, ch 1, [1 sl, ch 1, 1 dc], ch 1, 1 sc.
 - FO leaving long tail.
 - Wrap yarn across back to secure strap.
- Tail (Green, 2.0 mm)
 - o **Row1:** ch 19 (18)
 - **Row2-3:** 18 sc Join into round.
 - o **R4-R6:** 18 sc
 - o **R7:** (7 sc, dec) x 2 (16)
 - o **R8-R10:** 16 sc
 - o **R11:** (6 sc, dec) x 2 (14)
 - o **R12-R14:** 14 sc
 - o **R15:** (5 sc, dec) x 2 (12)
 - o **R16-R18:** 12 sc

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o R19: (4 sc, dec) x 2 (10)
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- o **R20:** 10 sc
- o **R21:** (3 sc, dec) x 2 (8)
- o **R22:** (2 sc, dec) x 2 (6)
- FO. Close tightly. Work Mint yarn into base chain: 8 sc, 2 sl st (center front), 8 sc.

• Fins (make 2, Mint)

- o **Row1:** ch 7 (6)
- o Row2: 6 sc, tch, turn
- o Row3: 4 sc, turn
- o Row4: 3 sc, turn
- o Row5: 2 sc, turn
- o **Row6:** 1 sc
- Row7: ch 1, sc around perimeter, working [1 sc, ch 1, 1 sc] at points.
- FO, attach both fins to end of tail.
- Hair (Red)
- Wig Cap (3.0 mm hook, loose)
 - o Row1: ch 25 (24)
 - **Row2–20:** 24 sc BLO
- FO. Gather top to form cap.
- Bangs (2.0 mm)
 - o **Row1:** ch 7 (6)
 - o **Row2:** 2 inc, 2 sc, 2 inc (10)
 - o Row3: 2 inc, 6 sc, 2 inc (14)
 - o **Row4:** 2 inc, 10 sc, 2 inc (18)
 - o **Row5:** 18 sc
- FO. Sew bangs to wig cap. Attach wig to head with sewing or fabric glue.

Optional Dresses

- Pink Dress
 - **Row 1:** ch 28 (27), sl st to join.
 - o **Row 2:** 27 sc
 - o **Row 3:** 5 sc, sk 1, 16 sc, sk 1, 5 sc (25)
 - o Row 4: 25 sc

- \circ **Row 5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 + 1 sc (31)
- o Row 6 (Light Pink, FLO): 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) x 3, 2 sc (24)
- o **Row 7:** (5 sc, inc) x 4 (28)
- Switch to 3.0 mm hook, join into round.
- **R8-R17:** (sc, inc) every few rounds to expand skirt evenly until ~38 sts
- o **R18 (FLO):** 38 sc
- o **Petticoat:** With White, work in BLO of R18: (sc, ch 3) x 38.
- Side Panels & Puffy Sleeves:
 - Embroider light pink belt around waist.
 - **■** Blue Dress
 - **■** Follow Pink Dress, but:
 - Colors: Light Blue (Row1-2), Navy (Row3-5), Turquoise (rest).
 - Stop at **R14** (shorter skirt).
 - Sleeves: use dc instead of popcorn.
 - Closure: tie straps or add tiny buttons.
 - **■** Bow (Light Blue)
 - **Row 1:** ch 11 (10)
 - **Row 2:** 10 sc
 - **Row 3-19:** 9 sc each row

FO. Cinch center, wrap with separate 9-sc strip. Attach to head with bobby pin or sew.
