

Bee Breezy from "Adventure Time"



Materials Needed & Measurements:

- **Suggested Yarn:** Ariadna Kaja
- **Yarn Weight:** Thread or lace weight
- **Yarn Color:** Yellow, black, white, and pink for accents
- **Hook Size**
 - 0.85 mm
 - 1.0 mm
- **Final toy height:** 5 cm (approximately 2 inches).
- **Needle:** Tapestry needle for sewing parts together and weaving in ends.

Abbreviations (US Crochet Terminology)

- **sc:** single crochet
- **inc:** increase (2 sc in the same stitch)
- **dec:** decrease (single crochet 2 stitches together)

- **sl st:** slip stitch
- **ch:** chain
- **FO:** fasten off

Special Stitches

- **Magic ring:** Used to start crocheting in the round.
- **Invisible decrease:** For a seamless finish on rounded shapes.

Stitching Instructions for Bee Breezy from "Adventure Time" Pattern:

Crochet the Head

Color: Yellow

Objective: Create a round, smooth head that forms the centerpiece of your Bee Breezy amigurumi.

- **Round 1:**
 - Begin by creating a **magic ring**. This technique allows you to start crocheting in the round without leaving a visible hole in the center.
 - Yarn over and insert your hook into the magic ring.
 - Work **6 single crochets (sc)** into the ring. This forms the foundation of the head.
 - **Tip:** Pull the tail of the magic ring to close the loop tightly.
- **Round 2:**
 - **Increase** in each stitch around to start shaping the head.
 - Work **1 sc** into each of the 6 stitches from the previous round.
 - After each sc, perform an **increase (inc)** by making 2 sc in the same stitch.
 - This results in **12 stitches** at the end of Round 2.
- **Round 3:**

- Continue shaping by alternating between regular and increased stitches.
- **Pattern:** [Sc in the next stitch, inc] repeat around.
- This will create **18 stitches** in total.
- **Note:** Ensure your increases are evenly spaced to maintain a smooth, spherical shape.
- **Rounds 4-6:**
 - **No increases or decreases** in these rounds.
 - Work **1 sc** into each stitch around for **3 consecutive rounds**.
 - This maintains the width of the head, ensuring it remains round and smooth.
- **Round 7:**
 - Begin shaping the top of the head by introducing decreases.
 - **Pattern:** [Sc in the next stitch, dec] repeat around.
 - This reduces the stitch count to **12 stitches**, starting to taper the head.
- **Round 8:**
 - Complete the head by decreasing further.
 - Perform **1 dec** in each stitch around.
 - This brings the total down to **6 stitches**.
 - **Finishing:** Lightly stuff the head with fiberfill to give it a firm shape. Ensure it's not overstuffed to maintain softness.
 - **Fasten Off (FO):** Cut the yarn, leaving a tail long enough for sewing. Pull the tail through the last stitch and secure.

Crochet the Body

- **Colors:** Yellow and Black (striped pattern)
- **Objective:** Create the striped body characteristic of Bee Breezy, ensuring it complements the head.
- **Round 1:**
 - Using **black yarn**, create a **magic ring**.
 - Work **6 sc** into the magic ring, similar to the head's base.

- **Tip:** Keep the magic ring tight to avoid gaps.
- **Round 2:**
 - **Increase** in each stitch around.
 - Work **1 sc** into each of the 6 stitches, performing an **inc** in each to reach **12 stitches**.
 - This starts forming the cylindrical shape of the body.
- **Round 3:**
 - Further shape the body by alternating stitches.
 - **Pattern:** [Sc in the next stitch, inc] repeat around.
 - This results in **18 stitches**, adding more width to the body.
- **Rounds 4-5:**
 - **Switch to yellow yarn** to create the striped pattern.
 - Work **1 sc** into each stitch around for **2 rounds**.
 - This maintains the width while introducing the color contrast.
- **Round 6:**
 - **Switch back to black yarn.**
 - Work **1 sc** into each stitch around.
 - This continues the striped pattern, ensuring Bee Breezy's iconic look.
- **Rounds 7-8:**
 - **Switch to yellow yarn** again.
 - Work **1 sc** into each stitch around for **2 final rounds**.
 - This completes the body with alternating stripes.
- **Finishing:**
 - **Fasten Off (FO):** Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing.
 - **Tip:** Lightly stuff the body with fiberfill, ensuring it's firm but not too tight.

Crochet the Wings

- **Color:** White
- **Objective:** Create delicate, semi-transparent wings to attach to the back of the body.
- **Round 1:**
 - Begin with a **magic ring**.
 - Work **6 sc** into the ring.
 - **Tip:** Keep the magic ring tight for a neat starting point.
- **Round 2:**
 - **Increase** to shape the wings.
 - **Pattern:** [Sc in the next stitch, inc] repeat around.
 - This creates **9 stitches**, giving the wings a slight expansion.
- **Round 3:**
 - Work **1 sc** into each stitch around without any increases.
 - Maintain the **9 stitches** to keep the wings flat and slightly rounded.
- **Finishing:**
 - **Fasten Off (FO):** Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing.
 - **Repeat:** Crochet a second wing following the same instructions to ensure symmetry.

Crochet the Antennae

- **Color:** Black
- **Objective:** Create two slim antennae that sit atop the head, adding character to Bee Breezy.
- **Antenna 1 & 2:**
 - **Chain (ch) 6:** Create a foundation chain of 6 stitches.
 - **Shape the Antenna:**
 - Insert the hook into the second chain from the hook.
 - **Slip Stitch (sl st)** back along the chain to form a loop.
 - **Fasten Off (FO):** Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for attaching.

- **Tip:** Keep the chains loose to allow the antennae to have a natural curve.

Assemble Bee Breezy

- **Objective:** Combine all the crocheted parts to form the complete Bee Breezy amigurumi.
- **Attach the Head to the Body:**
 - Use the **tapestry needle** and the yarn tail left from the head.
 - Sew the head securely to the top of the body, ensuring it's centered.
 - **Tip:** Weave the needle through the stitches multiple times for added strength.
- **Attach the Wings:**
 - Position the wings symmetrically on the back of the body.
 - Sew each wing using the yarn tails, making sure they're evenly spaced.
 - **Note:** Adjust the angle of the wings slightly outward for a dynamic look.
- **Attach the Antennae:**
 - Position the antennae on top of the head.
 - Sew each antenna securely, ensuring they stand upright.
 - **Tip:** You can gently bend the antennae to give Bee Breezy a more lively appearance.
- **Add Facial Features:**
 - **Cheeks:**
 - Using **pink yarn**, stitch small blush marks on each cheek.
 - **Technique:** Use the tapestry needle to make small, delicate stitches.
 - **Eyes:**
 - With a small piece of **black yarn**, create two tiny eyes.
 - **Alternative:** You can also use safety eyes or embroidery thread for a different effect.

Finishing Touches

- **Objective:** Ensure your Bee Breezy amigurumi is polished and all parts are securely in place.
- **Weave in All Loose Ends:**

- Use the tapestry needle to hide any loose yarn tails within the seams.
- **Tip:** This not only gives a clean look but also prevents unraveling.
- **Secure All Attachments:**
 - Double-check that the head, wings, and antennae are firmly attached.
 - Reinforce any areas that feel loose by sewing them again if necessary.
- **Final Shaping:**
 - Gently shape the head and body to ensure Bee Breezy stands or sits correctly.
 - Adjust the stuffing if needed to achieve the desired firmness.
- **Optional Embellishments:**
 - **Instruments:** If your pattern includes accessories like tiny instruments, crochet or add them following their specific instructions.
 - **Personal Touches:** Customize Bee Breezy with additional colors or details to make it uniquely yours.
