# Tunisian Balaclava Pattern

#### **Materials Needed & Measurements:**

- Suggested Yarn:
  - Ístex Léttlopi: A lightweight, warm yarn with a rustic texture, ideal for colder climates.
  - Yardage: Approximately 150–350 yards (137–320 meters) depending on the size.
- **Hook Size:** 7.0 mm Tunisian Crochet Hook
- Gauge: 11 stitches and 11 rows = 10 cm in Tunisian Simple Stitch (TSS).
- Pattern Measurements:
  - Suitable for adults, teens, and children.
  - o Unisex design for a range of sizes (measurements can be adjusted).
- Needle: Tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

#### **Abbreviations:**

- TSS: Tunisian Simple Stitch
- **Ch**: Chain
- SI st: Slip stitch

#### **Special Stitches:**

- **Tunisian Simple Stitch (TSS)**: The primary stitch used in this pattern, creating a dense yet flexible fabric.
  - How to TSS: Insert hook under the front vertical bar of the stitch, yarn over, pull
    up a loop, leave on hook. Repeat across the row, then follow the return pass.

#### Step-by-Step Instructions for the Tunisian Balaclava Pattern:

#### **Foundation Row**

- **Ch**: Chain a multiple of stitches to reach your desired width for the circumference of the balaclava (typically 55–75 ch for an adult, adjust for smaller sizes).
- **TSS Setup Row**: Starting in the second ch from the hook, work 1 **TSS** across the entire row. Do not turn your work. Leave all loops on the hook.
- **Return Pass**: Yarn over (YO), pull through one loop on the hook (this creates the edge), then **YO**, pull through two loops until only one loop remains on the hook.

#### **Main Body**

- TSS Rows: Continue working TSS rows as follows:
  - Forward Pass: Insert hook under the front vertical bar of each stitch, YO, pull up a loop. Leave all loops on the hook.
  - Return Pass: YO, pull through one loop, then YO, pull through two loops across
    the row until one loop remains.
- Repeat TSS Rows until the fabric measures approximately 25–30 cm (10–12 inches) or your desired length for the cowl portion.

### **Shaping for the Head Portion**

- Increase for Crown Width (Optional): For a snug head fit, increase by working 2 TSS in one stitch at intervals (e.g., every 5–7 stitches) during the next few rows.
- Taper the Crown:
  - As you reach the top, begin decreasing by skipping every 4th stitch during the forward pass.
  - Continue working the return pass as usual.

#### **Joining the Edges**

- After reaching the desired height for the head portion, fold the work in half with the right sides together.
- Use **sl st** to join the edges:
  - Insert the hook through both loops of the first stitch on each edge, YO, pull through both loops and the loop on the hook.
  - Repeat across the edge to create a seamless join.

## **Finishing Touches**

- Edge Finishing (Optional): To add a polished border, work a round of sl st or single crochet (sc) around the opening for the neck and face.
- Weave in Ends: Use a tapestry needle to weave in any loose ends.

#### **Customizations**

- For a Longer Neck: Add more rows of TSS to the cowl portion.
- For a Tighter Fit: Use a smaller hook or reduce the number of foundation stitches.
- Color Changes: Change yarn color mid-row or between rows for a striped effect.
