Aunt Lydia's Wisteria Doily



Materials Needed & Measurements:

- AUNT LYDIA'S Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10:
 - o 1 ball 493 French Rose (A)
 - o 1 ball 495 Wood Violet (B)
 - o 1 ball 275 Coral (C)
 - o 1 ball 450 Aqua (D)
- Susan Bates Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5mm (US 7)
- Tapestry needle
- **Doily Diameter:** 16" (40.5 cm)
- Gauge: Rounds 1-7 measure 4" (10 cm) across.

Abbreviations Used:

- $\mathbf{ch} = \mathbf{chain}$
- $\mathbf{sl} \ \mathbf{st} = \mathbf{slip} \ \mathbf{stitch}$
- $\mathbf{sc} = \text{single crochet}$
- dc = double crochet
- $\mathbf{sk} = \mathbf{skip}$
- $\mathbf{sp} = \mathbf{space}$
- rep = repeat

Stitching Instructions for Making Aunt Lydia's Wisteria Doily Pattern:

Round 1 (Color A- French Rose):



- Ch 6, sl st to first ch to form a ring.
- Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 15 dc in the ring.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3 to join. (16 dc)

Round 2 (Color B- Wood Violet):



- Join Color B in any dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 1 dc in the same st.
- 2 dc in the next dc. Rep from * around, ending with 2 dc in the final dc.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3. (32 dc)

Round 3 (Color C- Coral):



- Join Color C in any dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 1 dc in the same st.
- 1 dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc. Rep from * around, ending with 1 dc in the last dc and 2 dc in the last dc.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3. (48 dc)

Round 4 (Color D- Aqua):



- Join Color D in any dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 1 dc in the same st.
- 1 dc in the next 2 dc, 2 dc in the next dc. Rep from * around, ending with 2 dc in the last dc.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3. (64 dc)

Round 5 (Color A- French Rose):



- Join Color A in any dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 1 dc in the same st.
- 1 dc in the next 3 dc, 2 dc in the next dc. Rep from * around, ending with 1 dc in the last 3 dc and 2 dc in the last dc.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3. (80 dc)

Round 6 (Color B- Wood Violet):



- Join Color B in any dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 1 dc in the same st.
- 1 dc in the next 4 dc, 2 dc in the next dc. Rep from * around, ending with 1 dc in the last 4 dc and 2 dc in the last dc.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3. (96 dc)

Round 7 (Color C- Coral):



- Join Color C in any dc. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 1 dc in the same st.
- 1 dc in the next 5 dc, 2 dc in the next dc. Rep from * around, ending with 1 dc in the last 5 dc and 2 dc in the last dc.
- Sl st to the top of the ch-3. (112 dc)

Round 8 (Color D- Aqua):



- Join Color D in any dc. Ch 1, sc in same st.
- 1 sc in the next 6 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc, sc in the next 3 dc. Rep from * around, ending with 1 sc in the last 6 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc.
- Sl st to the first sc.

Round 9 (Color A- French Rose):



- Join Color A in any ch-3 sp. Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 2 dc in same sp.
- 3 dc in each ch-3 sp. Rep from * around, sl st to the top of ch-3. (48 dc)

Round 10 (Color B- Wood Violet):



- Join Color B in any sc. Ch 1, sc in same st.
- 1 sc in the next 3 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc, sc in the next 3 dc. Rep from * around, ending with 1 sc in the last 3 dc, ch 3, sk 3 dc.
- Sl st to first sc.

Finishing:



- Cut yarn, leaving a long tail for weaving.
- Use the tapestry needle to weave in all ends.
- Block the doily to the desired shape and size.

This completes the pattern for **Aunt Lydia's Wisteria Doily**, with an intricate design that combines lovely color changes and delicate crochet techniques!
