

Crochet Floral Doily Coaster



Materials Needed & Measurements:

- **Yarn:** Fingering weight 100% cotton (8g), e.g., Alize Bella yarn (colorway 28, Rose)
- **Hook:** 3mm crochet hook
- **Other Tools:** Scissors, yarn needle for weaving in ends
- **Size:** 16 cm (6.3 inches) in diameter

Abbreviations:

- **ch** = Chain
- **sl st** = Slip stitch
- **sc** = Single crochet
- **hdc** = Half double crochet
- **dc** = Double crochet
- **st(s)** = Stitch(es)
- **()** = Repeat the instructions in parentheses as indicated
- **1dc** = One double crochet stitch
- **7dc** = Seven double crochet stitches
- **ch1** = Chain 1 stitch
- **ch2** = Chain 2 stitches
- **ch3** = Chain 3 stitches
- **ch5** = Chain 5 stitches
- **1sc** = One single crochet stitch

- **1hdc** = One half double crochet stitch
- **(ch1 + 1hdc)** = Chain 1 stitch followed by one half double crochet stitch

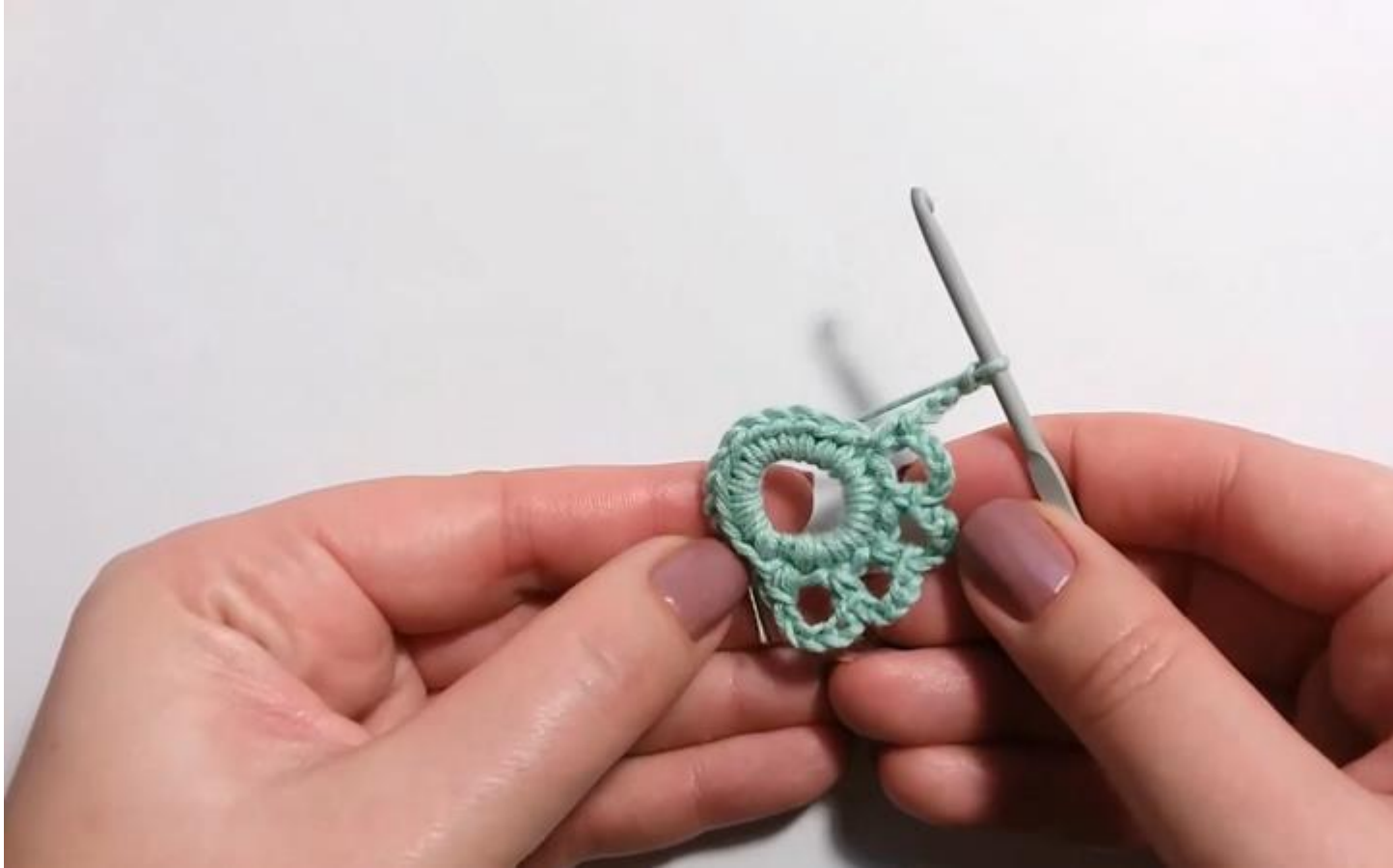
Stitching Instructions for Making the Crochet Floral Doily Coaster Pattern:

Round 1:



- **ch6**- Begin with a chain of 6 stitches.
- Join with a **sl st** into the first **ch** to form a ring.
- **ch1**- This does not count as a stitch.
- Work **16sc** (single crochet) into the ring formed by the chains.
- Join with a **sl st** into the first **sc** to close the round.

Round 2:



- **ch3**- This counts as your first **dc** (double crochet).
- **ch3**- Chain 3 stitches.
- **(skip 1 st, 1dc into next st, ch3)**- Repeat the instructions in parentheses 7 times around the ring.
 - **skip 1 st**- Skip the next stitch.
 - **1dc into next st**- Make 1 double crochet stitch into the next stitch.
 - **ch3**- Chain 3 stitches.
- Join with a **sl st** into the top of the initial **ch3**.

Round 3:



- **sl st** into the next **ch3** space (to move into position).
- **ch1**- This does not count as a stitch.
- Work into the same **ch3** space:
 - **1sc** (single crochet),
 - **1hdc** (half double crochet),
 - **3dc** (double crochet),
 - **1hdc** (half double crochet),
 - **1sc** (single crochet).
- **(1sc, 1hdc, 3dc, 1hdc, 1sc)**- Repeat the sequence inside the next **ch3** space. Repeat 7 times around.
- Join with a **sl st** into the first **sc** to close the round.

Round 4:



- **sl st** into the next 3 stitches (to move into position).
- **ch1**- This does not count as a stitch.
- **1sc** (single crochet) into the base of that **ch1**.
- **ch5**- Chain 5 stitches.
- **(skip 6 sts, 1sc into next st, ch5)**- Repeat these instructions 7 times around the ring:
 - **skip 6 sts**- Skip the next 6 stitches.
 - **1sc into next st**- Make 1 single crochet stitch into the next stitch.
 - **ch5**- Chain 5 stitches.
- Join with a **sl st** into the first **sc** to close the round.

Round 5:



- **ch3**- This counts as your first **dc** (double crochet).
- Work **7dc** (double crochet) into the next **ch5** space.
- **(1dc into next st, 7dc into next ch5 space)**- Repeat this sequence 7 times around the ring:
 - **1dc into next st**- Make 1 double crochet stitch into the next stitch.
 - **7dc into next ch5 space**- Work 7 double crochet stitches into the next **ch5** space.
- Join with a **sl st** into the top of the initial **ch3** to close the round.

Round 6:



- **ch3**- This counts as your first **dc** (double crochet).
- **ch2**- Chain 2 stitches.
- **(skip 1 st, 1dc into next st, ch2)** – Repeat these instructions 31 times around the ring:
 - **skip 1 st**- Skip the next stitch.
 - **1dc into next st** – Make 1 double crochet stitch into the next stitch.
 - **ch2**- Chain 2 stitches.
- Join with a **sl st** into the top of the initial **ch3** to close the round.

Round 7:



- **ch3**- This counts as your first **dc** (double crochet).
- **(ch3, 1dc into next st)**- Repeat this sequence 31 times around the ring:
 - **ch3**- Chain 3 stitches.
 - **1dc into next st**- Make 1 double crochet stitch into the next stitch.
- Join with **ch1 + 1hdc** (half double crochet) on top of the initial **ch3** to close the round.

Round 8:



- **ch1**- This does not count as a stitch.
- **1sc** into the (**ch1 + 1hdc**) space from the previous round.
- Work **7dc** (double crochet) into the next **ch3** space.
- (**1sc into next ch3 space, 7dc into next ch3 space**) – Repeat this sequence 15 times around the ring:
 - **1sc into next ch3 space**- Make 1 single crochet stitch into the next **ch3** space.
 - **7dc into next ch3 space**- Work 7 double crochet stitches into the next **ch3** space.
- Join with a **sl st** into the first **sc** to close the round.

Finish:



- **ch1**- Chain 1 stitch.
- Cut off the yarn, fasten off, and weave in all the loose ends with a yarn needle or crochet hook.
