

# Crochet Flower Granny Square Pattern



Create a charming floral-themed square that works beautifully for shawls, blankets, borders, or afghans.

The **Crochet Flower Granny Square** features a layered design starting with a double crochet circle, followed by a petal-shaped cluster round, framed with a soft green for leaves, and finished with a square border.

This pattern is ideal for crocheters comfortable with basic and special stitches like **DC2TOG** and **Cluster Stitch**.

## Materials:

- **Yarn:** Red Heart Super Saver (Worsted Weight/Medium #4)
  - White - 0.22 oz / 20 yds
  - Baby Pink (Light Pink) - 0.11 oz / 10 yds
  - Tea Leaf (Green) - 0.11 oz / 10 yds
  - Perfect Pink (Medium Pink) - 0.11 oz / 10 yds

- **Hook:** 5.5 mm (Size I)
- **Notions:** Yarn needle and scissors

## Measurements:

- **Gauge:** 4 DC x 2 rows = 1 inch
- **Finished Size:** 5.5 x 5.5 inches

## Abbreviations:

- **CH** - Chain
- **SC** - Single Crochet
- **HDC** - Half Double Crochet
- **DC** - Double Crochet
- **TR** - Treble Crochet
- **CL** - Cluster Stitch
- **DC2TOG** - Double Crochet 2 Stitches Together
- **SLST** - Slip Stitch
- **ST(s)** - Stitch(es)

## Instructions for Making the Crochet Flower Granny Square Pattern:

### Round 1 (Center - White):



- CH 2, make 16 DC into a **magic circle**.
- SLST to the first DC to join.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.

Alternative: CH 3, work 16 DC into 3rd CH from hook, SLST to first DC. Fasten off.

## **Round 2 (Petal Base - Light Pink):**



- Join with SLST to any ST of Round 1.
- CH 2, DC in same ST (acts as first DC2TOG).
- CH 2, DC2TOG in next ST, CH 1, DC2TOG in next ST - repeat this **7 times** total.
- CH 2, DC2TOG, CH 1, SLST to first DC.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.
- **You should now have:**
  - 16 DC2TOG clusters
  - 8 CH-2 spaces
  - 8 CH-1 spaces

### **Round 3 (Petals - Medium Pink):**





- SLST into any CH-1 space from Round 2.
- CH 1, SC in the same space.
- CH 2, (CL, CH 1, CL) into CH-2 space, CH 2, SC into next CH-1 space - repeat this **7 more times**.
- CH 2, (CL, CH 1, CL) in CH-2 space, CH 2, SLST to first SC.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.
- **Petals formed:** 8 Each CH-2 space holds a petal made with two CLs separated by CH 1.

#### **Round 4 (Leaf Round - Green):**



- Work into the **SCs between petals only**.
- SLST into any SC, CH 2.
- (DC, TR, CH 2, TR, DC) in same SC - this forms a corner.
- CH 4, HDC in next SC, CH 4, (DC, TR, CH 2, TR, DC) in next SC - repeat this for a total of **4 corners and 4 sides**.
- End with CH 4, SLST to first DC.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.

### **Round 5 (Square Border - White):**



- SLST to any corner CH-2 space, CH 2.
- (2 DC, CH 2, 2 DC) in corner,
- DC in next 2 STs, 4 DC in CH-4 space, skip next ST, 4 DC in next CH-4 space, DC in next 2 STs - repeat this pattern around.
- SLST to first DC.
- Fasten off and weave in ends.

**Tip:** To get **odd-numbered stitch counts** per side (e.g., for joining squares), **work 1 DC into the HDC** in Round 4 instead of skipping it.

### **Finishing:**





Once complete, block the square if necessary to smooth out the edges. You can create a lovely floral blanket or shawl by making multiple squares and sewing them together.
