

Free Hanging Hearts Valentine Crochet Pattern



Pattern Description:

This Valentine's Day wall hanging features rows of colorful hearts worked into a crisp white background, creating a charming and festive decoration.

Using worsted-weight yarn in shades of pink, yellow, green, and purple, each heart is carefully stitched with simple single crochet rows, making it beginner-friendly yet visually striking.

Finished with a soft fringe and hung on a dowel or branch, this piece measures about 6 inches wide by 15 inches long, perfect for gifting or brightening your space.

Materials Needed & Measurements:

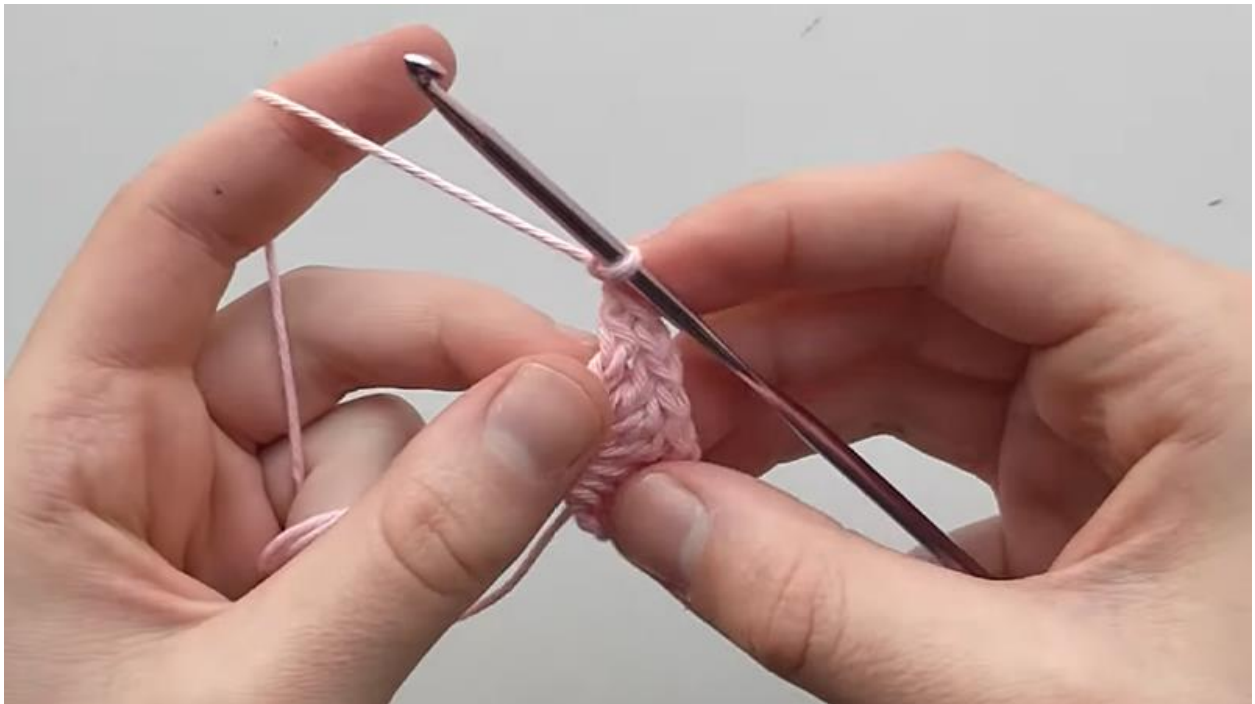
- **Yarn:**
 - **We Crochet Brava Worsted in White** - approx. 75 yards
 - **We Crochet Brava Worsted in Cotton Candy** - approx. 15 yards
 - **We Crochet Brava Worsted in Custard** - approx. 12 yards
 - **We Crochet Brava Worsted in Alfalfa** - approx. 15 yards
 - **We Crochet Brava Worsted in Lady Slipper** - approx. 12 yards
- **Yarn Weight: Weight 4 Worsted Weight Yarn**

- **Hook:** 4.50 mm Crochet Hook
- **Notions:** Yarn Needle, Scissors, Hand Steamer (optional)
- **Measurements:** 6 inches wide x 15 inches long (not including fringe)

Stitches & Abbreviations Used:

- **Stitch Key (US Terms):**
 - **Ch** = Chain
 - **St/sts** = Stitch(es)
 - **Sc** = Single Crochet
- **Color Abbreviations:**
 - **W** = White
 - **CC** = Cotton Candy
 - **C** = Custard
 - **A** = Alfalfa
 - **LS** = Lady Slipper

Instructions for Making the Hanging Hearts Valentine Crochet Pattern:



Begin by chaining 24 in White.

Pattern Rows (23 stitches per row)

- **Row 1:** sc in the 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across. Ch 1, turn. (23)

- **Row 2 - Row 4:** In White, sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (23)

Lady Slipper (LS) Heart Section:

- **Row 5:** 11 (W), 1 (LS), 11 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 6:** 10 (W), 3 (LS), 10 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 7:** 9 (W), 5 (LS), 9 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 8:** 8 (W), 3 (LS), 1 (W), 3 (LS), 8 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 9:** 7 (W), 3 (LS), 3 (W), 3 (LS), 7 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 10:** 6 (W), 3 (LS), 5 (W), 3 (LS), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 11:** 5 (W), 3 (LS), 3 (W), 1 (LS), 3 (W), 3 (LS), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 12:** 4 (W), 3 (LS), 3 (W), 3 (LS), 3 (W), 3 (LS), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 13:** 4 (W), 3 (LS), 2 (W), 5 (LS), 2 (W), 3 (LS), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 14:** 4 (W), 7 (LS), 1 (W), 7 (LS), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 15:** 5 (W), 5 (LS), 3 (W), 5 (LS), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 16:** 6 (W), 3 (LS), 5 (W), 3 (LS), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 17 – Row 20:** In White, sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (23)

Alfalfa (A) Heart Section:

- **Row 21:** 11 (W), 1 (A), 11 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 22:** 10 (W), 3 (A), 10 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 23:** 9 (W), 5 (A), 9 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 24:** 8 (W), 7 (A), 8 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 25:** 7 (W), 9 (A), 7 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 26:** 6 (W), 11 (A), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 27:** 5 (W), 13 (A), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 28 - Row 29:** 4 (W), 15 (A), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 30:** 4 (W), 7 (A), 1 (W), 7 (A), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 31:** 5 (W), 5 (A), 3 (W), 5 (A), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 32:** 6 (W), 3 (A), 5 (W), 3 (A), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 33 - Row 36:** In White, sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (23)

Custard (C) Heart Section:

- **Row 37:** 11 (W), 1 (C), 11 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 38:** 10 (W), 3 (C), 10 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 39:** 9 (W), 5 (C), 9 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 40:** 8 (W), 3 (C), 1 (W), 3 (C), 8 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 41:** 7 (W), 3 (C), 3 (W), 3 (C), 7 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 42:** 6 (W), 3 (C), 5 (W), 3 (C), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 43:** 5 (W), 3 (C), 3 (W), 1 (C), 3 (W), 3 (C), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 44:** 4 (W), 3 (C), 3 (W), 3 (C), 3 (W), 3 (C), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 45:** 4 (W), 3 (C), 2 (W), 5 (C), 2 (W), 3 (C), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 46:** 4 (W), 7 (C), 1 (W), 7 (C), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 47:** 5 (W), 5 (C), 3 (W), 5 (C), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)

- **Row 48:** 6 (W), 3 (C), 5 (W), 3 (C), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 49 - Row 52:** In White, sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (23)

Cotton Candy (CC) Heart Section:

- **Row 53:** 11 (W), 1 (CC), 11 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 54:** 10 (W), 3 (CC), 10 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 55:** 9 (W), 5 (CC), 9 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 56:** 8 (W), 7 (CC), 8 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 57:** 7 (W), 9 (CC), 7 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 58:** 6 (W), 11 (CC), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 59:** 5 (W), 13 (CC), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 60 - Row 61:** 4 (W), 15 (CC), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 62:** 4 (W), 7 (CC), 1 (W), 7 (CC), 4 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 63:** 5 (W), 5 (CC), 3 (W), 5 (CC), 5 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 64:** 6 (W), 3 (CC), 5 (W), 3 (CC), 6 (W). Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Row 65 - Row 69:** In White sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (23)
- **Fasten off** after Row 69, **leaving at least a 2-foot tail.**

Attaching the Fringe

To create and attach the fringe:

- **Cut 12-inch pieces of yarn in White.** You will need **3 strands to complete 1 fringe.**
- Grab 3 strands of yarn in White.
- With a crochet hook, **push the hook through the far left foundation chain.**
- **Fold the 3 strands of yarn in half**, looping the middle of the strands onto the crochet hook.
- **Fold the strands through the loop.**
- **Tighten to create the fringe.**
- **Repeat for every other foundation chain.**

Hanging the Project

To attach the project to a dowel rod or tree branch and hang it:

- Using a **yarn needle**, weave the tail (left after fastening off) over the dowel/branch and back under into the first stitch on the top of the wall hanging.
- **Repeat for each stitch** on top of the wall hanging.
- **Knot off and weave in your ends.**
- To hang the project, **drill 2 small holes on either side of the branch/dowel.**
- **Thread through both holes with cotton yarn and knot off both ends.**
- **Trim the excess yarn.** You may also use your preferred method of hanging the project.
